FOOTPATH 34 RADWINTER DISTRICT OF UTTLESFORD

This Order is made by Essex County Council ("the authority") under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the authority that in the interest of the owner of the land crossed by the footpath described in paragraph 1 of this order it is expedient that the line of the path should be diverted.

The landowner has agreed to defray any compensation which becomes payable in consequence of the coming into force of this order and any expenses incurred in the order making and bringing the new site of the path into a fit condition for use by the public.

Uttlesford District Council has been consulted and has consented to the making of the order as required by section 120(2) of the 1980 Act.

BY THIS ORDER:

- 1) The public right of way over the land situated at Thakes Cottage known as Footpath 34 in the District of Uttlesford and shown by a bold continuous black line on the Plan numbered RAD 34B contained in this order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this order shall be stopped up after 35 days from the date of confirmation of this order
- 2) There shall at the end of 28 days from the date of confirmation of this order be a public footpath over land situated at Thakes Cottage, Radwinter End known as Footpath 34 in the District of Uttlesford as described in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by a bold broken black line on the Plan numbered RAD 34B contained in this order.

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF EXISTING PATHS OR WAYS

A part length of Footpath 34 of unknown width shown by a bold continuous black line on the Order Plan commencing from point **A** at grid reference 56160,23934 on Golden Lane running in a south, south easterly across the garden of Thakes Cottage for a total distance of approximately 75 metres to point **B** at grid reference 56162,23927 and then running in a south easterly direction for a total distance of 41 metres to point **D** at grid reference 56166,23924

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF NEW PATHS OR WAYS

A footpath being 2 metres in width shown by a bold broken black line on the Order Plan commencing at the aforementioned point **A** at grid reference 56160,23934 running in a south easterly direction for a distance of approximately 65 metres to point **C** at grid reference 56165,23930 then in a south-south easterly direction for a further distance of approximately 56 metres to the aforementioned point **D** where footpath 34 continues unaffected
