PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER HIGHWAYS ACT 1980 ESSEX COUNTY COUNCIL FOOTPATHS 74 and 76 RADWINTER

This Order is made by Essex County Council ("the authority") under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the authority that in the interests of the landowner of the land crossed by the public rights of way described in paragraph 1 of this Order, it is expedient that the rights of way should be diverted.

The landowner, has agreed to defray any compensation which becomes payable in consequence of the coming into force of this order and any expenses which are incurred in bringing the new site of the path into a fit condition for use by the public.

Uttlesford District Council has been consulted and has consented to the making of the Order as required by section 120(2) of the 1980 Act.

BY THIS ORDER:

1. The public rights of way known as Footpaths 74 and 76 over land situate at 'The Grange' in the parish of Radwinter in the District of Uttlesford and shown by a bold continuous line on the Plan RADW 74 M contained in this Order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order, shall be stopped up after 35 days from the date of confirmation of this Order.

2. There shall at the end of 28 days from the date of confirmation of this Order be public footpaths over the land situate at The Grange in the Parish of Radwinter in the District of Uttlesford described in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by bold broken lines on the Plan RADW 74 M contained in this Order.

SCHEDULE

[PART 1]

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF EXISTING PATH OR WAY

A part length of Footpath 74 Radwinter of undefined width and shown by a bold black continuous line on the Order Plan, commencing at point **P** where the access drive to The Grange bends from a north-west to a south west direction and running in a south westerly direction along the access drive to the south of Grange farm bungalow for a distance of 150 metres to point **N** on the east side of The Grange residence and then continues in a generally northerly direction on the western side of the tennis court for a distance of 175 metres to point **M**.

A part length of Footpath 76 of undefined width and shown by a bold black continuous line on the Order Plan, commencing from point \mathbf{Q} on the access drive, 20 metres south-east of the aforementioned point P and running in a north easterly direction across the field for a distance of 266 metres to point \mathbf{R} to the east side of the ancient mound and then continues in an easterly direction on the south side of the hedge for a distance of 106 metres to point \mathbf{T} where it connects to the highway.

[PART 2]

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF NEW PATH OR WAY

A footpath being 2 metres in width shown by a bold broken line on the Order Map commencing at the aforementioned point **P** and running in a north westerly direction for a distance of 175 metres to the aforementioned point **M** where it continues unaffected.

A footpath being 2 metres in width, shown by a bold broken black line on the Order Map commencing from the aforementioned point \mathbf{P} and running in a north easterly direction along the field edge for a distance of 205 metres to point \mathbf{S} onto an existing track and continuing on the northern side of the hedge in an easterly direction on the north side of the mound for a distance of 203 metres to point \mathbf{V} where it connects to the highway 6 metres further north than the current path.
