#### Changes at senior management level at UDC

Angela Knight has been appointed as Chief Operating Officer, Strategic Director.

Starting her new role on 8<sup>th</sup> July, she will take over some of the duties of Peter Holt (who remains CEO) to allow him to focus more of his time on Local Government Reorganisation (thus hopefully maximizing the benefits that Uttlesford Residents will receive when these changes occur- he will also aim to ensure that the impacts on UDC staff are minimized).

Angela will take over direct line management responsibility for legal services and elections, as well as her current span of responsibility covering performance, risk and contracts; procurement; internal audit; programme and project management; economic development and car parks; and human resources and organisational development – as well as leading on coordinating the Blueprint Uttlesford change programme.

#### Stansted Airport Expansion, Planning and Noise

I have received an email from a resident of Great Sampford that they have not been able to receive compensation for noise from planes approaching Stansted Airport. I believe that this is because the noise contours are very narrowly defined, but in reality, using tracking APPS, aircraft use much wider areas when landing and apparently do not stick to the restricted approaches.

I therefore wondered if other residents of The Sampfords had had any success with noise compensation, and whether the official noise contours are at all representative. I have contacted Stansted Airport Watch (was Stop Stansted Expansion) who agreed that those residing outside noise contours are not eligible for compensation. How many residents in Radwinter are troubled by airport related noise?

On a related matter, when discussing the response to the planning application for passenger numbers to increase to 51m at another Parish Council in this ward (Hempstead), it was pointed out that the information presented with the application is incomplete about noise and they will be noting that noise contours do not reflect the actual noise suffered by residents.
