

PUBLIC NOTICE

The Essex County Council (High Street, Hempstead)(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2017

Notice is hereby given that the Essex County Council intends, not less than seven days from the date of this notice, to make the above Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

Effect of the order: To temporarily close that length of High Street, in the Parish of Hempstead in the District of Uttlesford from its junction with Witchtree Lane, south west for a distance of approximately 1300 metres to its junction with B1054 Hill Road.

The closure is scheduled to commence on 9 January 2017 for six weeks or where appropriate signs are showing and weather permitting.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while highway improvement works are undertaken.

The alternative route will be via B1054 Hill Road, B1054, B1053 Walden Road, B1053 Radwinter Road, B184 Thaxted Road, Peaslands Road, Mount Pleasant Road, Borough Lane, London Road, B1052 Newport Road, B1052 Sparrowsend Hill, B1383 London Road, B1383 Newmarket Road, B184, A11, A1307 Cambridge Road, A1307 Park Hill, A1307, A1017 Haverhill Bypass, B1057 Bumpstead Road, B1057 Haverhill Road, B1054 North Street, B1054 Water Lane, B1054, and vice versa.

Access for emergency service vehicles and pedestrians will be maintained at all times during the closure.

The Order will come into effect on 9 January 2017 and may continue in force for 18 months or until the works have been completed, whichever is the earlier.
