

Public notice

The Essex County Council (Footpath 89, Radwinter)(Temporary Prohibition of Use) Order 2016

Further to notices published on 24 & 31 March 2016, notice is hereby given that the Essex County Council has made the above Order under Section 14 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

Effect of the order: to temporarily close Footpath 89, Radwinter in the District of Uttlesford from its intersection with Footpath 87 for a distance of 90m north-Westerly direction.

The closure is now scheduled to commence on 4 April 2016 to 4 October 2016, weather permitting, or where appropriate signs are showing, and is required for the safety of the public and workforce while repair works are undertaken on the tidal embankment.

The alternative route will be the trodden path currently being utilised by the public..

The Order will come into effect on 4 April 2016 and may continue in force for 6 months, or until the works are finished, whichever is the earlier.
