# Public notice

**NOTICE OF THE CONFIRMATION OF ORDERS  
PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDERS 2019  
IN THE DISTRICT OF UTTLESFORD**

**HIGHWAYS ACT 1980 – SECTION 119  
FOOTPATHS 24, 28 and 30 RADWINTER**

The above Orders confirmed on 8<sup>th</sup> April, 2019 under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 will divert Footpaths 24, 28 and 30 in the parish of Radwinter in the District of Uttlesford as shown on the Order maps contained in these Orders.

A part length of Footpath 24 commencing from grid reference 56120,23846 where it connects with Footpath 25 Radwinter and running in an easterly direction for a distance of 160 metres to grid reference 56135,23845 west of the pond by Cowlass Hall will be diverted to a new route commencing at the same above starting point and running in a north north easterly direction along the field boundary for a distance of 117 metres to grid reference 56125,23856.

A part length of Footpath 28 commencing from grid reference 56125,23856 and running in a south easterly direction for a distance of 154 metres then continuing as Footpath 24 in a southerly then a south easterly direction running between the pond and Cowlass Hall for a further distance of 176 metres to grid reference 56148,23835 where it connects to Footpath 22 Radwinter, will be diverted to a new route commencing at the same above starting point and running in an east south easterly direction along the field boundary for a distance of 140 metres to grid reference 56138,23853 and then continuing in a north north easterly direction then in an east south easterly direction following the field boundary for a further distance of 177 metres to grid reference 56154,23851 where it connects to Footpath 22 Radwinter.

A part length of Footpath 30 Radwinter commencing at grid reference 56178,23773 and running in a west south westerly direction across the garden belonging to Sellards Barn for a distance of 62 metres to reference 56172,23771 and then in a southerly direction to the footbridge on the north side of the stream for a distance of 22 metres to grid reference 56172,23767 north of the highway, the B1054, will be diverted to a new route commencing from the same above starting point and running in a south westerly and then a southerly direction along the access drive for a distance of 46 metres to grid reference 56177,23769 then in a generally westerly direction parallel with and on the north side of the stream for a distance of 48 metres to where it continues unaffected.

A copy of the above Orders and Order Maps have been placed in and may be seen free of charge at Uttlesford Council Offices, London Road, Saffron Walden during normal working hours. Copies of the Orders and Order maps are available on request from County Hall, Chelmsford at a charge.

The new routes will come into effect on 6<sup>th</sup> May, 2019. However, if any person aggrieved by an order, wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or of any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order, he or she may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within 6 weeks from the date of this Notice, make an application to the High Court.
